Read John 19:25-27!

Memorize John 21:15 – *“So when they had finished breakfast, Jesus said to Simon Peter, ‘Simon, son of John, do you love Me more than these?’ He said to them, ‘Yes, Lord; You know that I love You.’ He said to Him, ‘Tend My lambs.’”*

2. Psalm 103:13-16 describes God’s creation and care of us through our mothers. What are some of the truths that stand out from this passage and how does this encourage us today?
3. Rosaria Butterfield defines, “Radical ordinary hospitality is this: using your Christian home in a daily way to make strangers neighbours and neighbours family of God.” How does this show that hospitality is not just “women’s work”? How are you making strangers neighbours and neighbours family of God?
4. Why did Jesus delegate care of His mother to John when it was the responsibility of His half-brothers?
5. Jesus gives you people to adopt and care for as family. Who are they?
6. What are some of the specific ways that we can treat others as family?
7. Why as believers do we always have a place to call home and a people you can call family? How have you seen this to be true?
