

Reflection and Discussion Questions for the Week of May 20, 2018

Read John 21:18-25

Memorize John 21:15 – *“So when they had finished breakfast, Jesus said to Simon Peter, ‘Simon, son of John, do you love Me more than these?’ He said to them, ‘Yes, Lord; You know that I love You.’ He said to Him, ‘Tend My lambs.’”*

What encouraged, challenged and or confused you about this passage or sermon?

1. Have you even considered your calling before? How have you understood a calling to be?
2. What kinds of cost have you experienced in pursuit of your calling? Is there a call from God you are avoiding because of the cost?
3. How have you resented the calling of God on your life? Do you ever think that God isn't being fair? What hope do you have?
4. Because of comparing yourself to others, do you ever feel like you are unable to fulfill your calling? What encouragement does God have for you?
5. What is your highest calling? How has God used trial and denial to prepare you for that?
6. Reflect on 1 Peter 4:12-16. How do your perspectives on life need to change?
