Read John 17:1-12!

Memorize John 17:3 – *“This is eternal life, that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent.”*

2. What are some of the “mountains” you are asking God to move in your life?
3. Why is it so amazing that Jesus would be praying for you?
4. What are some things we know from John 17 that Jesus is praying for us?
5. Why did it seem ludicrous and yet is so liberating that Jesus would want God the Father to be glorified through His death?
6. Why is Jesus not denying His divinity in verse 3?
7. What does Jesus mean when He prays in verse 11, *“may they be one as We are”*? How is this prayer answered in our lives?
