

## Reflection and Discussion Questions for the Week of November 18, 2018

Read Haggai 1:12-15!

**Memorize Haggai 1:5-6a** – *“Now therefore, thus says the Lord of Hosts: Consider your ways. You have sown much and harvested little.”*

What encouraged, challenged and or confused you about this passage or sermon?

1. Describe a time when you obeyed the voice of the Lord. What were the results?
2. It only took two people, Zerubbabel and Joshua, to lead all the people of God to obey the voice of the Lord their God (v. 12). What people could you influence to obey the voice of the Lord and in what command(s)?
3. What are some of the benefits of obeying the Lord from this passage?
4. What does it mean that “the Lord stirred up the spirits” of Zerubbabel and Joshua? (v. 14)
5. What would it look like if the Lord stirred up your spirit? The spirits in our church?
6. What is the significance that God is described as the Lord of hosts? (v. 14)
7. What pressing command of God do you need to obey the voice of the Lord? What pressing command of God does our church need to obey the voice of the Lord?
