

Reflection and Discussion Questions for the Week of February 10, 2019

Read Ezra 3:8-11!

Memorize Ezra 3:11 – *“And they sang responsively, praising and giving thanks to the Lord, ‘For He is good, for His steadfast love endures forever toward Israel.’ And all the people shouted with a great shout when they praised the LORD, because the foundation of the house of the LORD was laid.”*

What encouraged, challenged and or confused you about this passage or sermon?

1. When you gather together with God’s people, what do you expect to happen?
2. What was the minimum age for service in rebuilding the Temple and why?
3. Why is it important that families unite to do God’s work rather than one family do all the work?
4. What were the instruments that were used to celebrate the completion of the foundation of the Temple? Why?
5. What were the three elements of worship the people did? (v. 11) Why are these still important in our worship of God?
6. Why does building lead to worship?
7. Why is God good?
